Players entering the tournament agree to abide by **the FIDE Laws of Chess** and the decisions of the controllers, which will be final. We reserve the right to refuse entries or transfer entrants from one section to another at any point.

Mobile phones and electronic devices are only permitted in the playing area provided the device is completely switched off. During play, such devices must be placed in a bag as agreed with the arbiter. Both players are forbidden to use this bag without permission of the arbiter.

Prizes will be paid by direct bank transfer within seven days of the end of the congress. No player may receive more than one individual prize. Prizes will be shared in the event of a tie.

Refreshments will be available on the premises, provided by the Cokethorpe School catering team, and will include a comprehensive range of hot and cold food and drinks.

The title of **Oxfordshire Chess Champion** and the **Championship Trophy** will be awarded to the eligible player with the highest combined score in the Open sections of the Witney Weekend Congress and the 2018 Kidlington Chess Tournament.
